#### APALI LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT MODEL

During the last two decades, APALI has pioneered an innovative civic leadership development model emphasizing both leadership training and network community. APALI's leadership development approach is wholistic, cross-generational, culturally-informed, socially-conscious, transformative, and empowering.

Since 1999, APALI has graduated 1355 leadership programs participants and students from its De Anza College educational program. APALI has also developed a growing network community of over 400 civically-engaged alumni and over 90 current and former public officials in the Silicon Valley/Bay Area region.






