YOUTH LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Signature program for students interested in government and civic involvement. Students explore identity and history, social issues and policy, and community empowerment. LEADERSHIP TRAINING INTERNSHIP

Intermediate-level training for college students who lead the Youth Leadership Academy. Interns develop skills for group leadership, youth empowerment, and community education. Each intern is awarded an \$800 stipend and a certificate of completion. Most APALI interns have career or civic aspirations in the public, non-profit, and educational sectors.

COMMUNITY-BASED LEADERSHIP EDUCATION

CIVIC LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Innovative 12-week seminar program in January on civic involvement, public policy, and understanding the Latino and Asian Pacific American communities. For practicing and emerging leaders, public officials, non-profit board members/staff, professionals, commissioners, college students, and activists. Program led by former mayors Michael Chang and Ruben Abrica.



SENIOR FELLOWS PROGRAM

Leadership program for public officials, veteran policy-oriented opinion leaders, and public interest advocates with quarterly gatherings for policy discussions, experience sharing, and fellowship. Two thirds of the APALI Senior Fellows are current or former elected public officials.
