General Information

- 1. The meeting will be recorded, the microphone will not be muted, and the camera will not be turned off at any point.
- 2. Zoom Participants must be logged in to their Zoom accounts.
- 3. Zoom Participants will only be able to chat with or send messages to the Host and Co-Hosts.
- 4. Only all complaints submitted by the original deadline of 4:00 PM Monday, March 10th, 2025 will be reviewed.
- 5. It is at the Senate's discretion to determine the validity, applicability, and severity of all complaints
- 6. Complainants must be present in person or over Zoom for their complaints to be brought up for discussion
- 7. Complainants must be present in person or over Zoom to present their complaints and answer questions from the Senate
- 8. Evidence can include, but is not limited to, documents, photos, video, AND live statements from individuals involved and/or witnesses made in person or over Zoom
- 9. Any evidence, OLD or NEW, can be presented specifically and only regarding all complaints that were submitted by the deadline at 4PM March 10th, 2025.
- 10. Individuals and/or Witnesses must be present in person or over Zoom to present their statements and answer questions from the Senate
- 11. Candidates should be present in person or over Zoom to present their responses and answer questions from the Senate
- 12. It is at the Senate's discretion to determine the validity and applicability of all evidence
- 13. All decisions of the Senate are final and cannot be appealed
