Structure

- 1. The members of the Administration Committee will introduce the complaints
- Complainants will present their complaints and all evidence including statements from individuals involved and witnesses (must be present in person or over Zoom)
- 3. Candidates in complaints will provide a response if present
- 4. The Senate will ask questions of complainants, individuals involved, witnesses, and candidates in the complaints
- 5. Complainants, individuals involved, witnesses, and candidates in the complaints may raise their hands to speak and if called upon may address the Senate
- 6. Once the open discussion period has ended, the Senate will publicly deliberate on the complaints (everyone must remain quiet during the deliberation period)
- 7. The Senate will make any motions as appropriate
- 8. All decisions of the Senate are final and cannot be appealed
